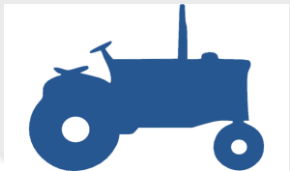
9 Action plans



9. Action Plans



- As you went through the protocols you would have identified some improvements you wish to implement to improve farm biosecurity
- These need to be formulated into an action plan with priorities, due dates and estimate of costs.



Example action plan



Improvements in biosecurity processes	Priority 1=high, 5=low	Due Date	Estimated Cost
Contain the water from the wash down by bunding the wash down area.	2	May2020	\$1000
Set up a place near wash down where people can be asked to sign in and out on the register and pick up the biosecurity and health and safety hazards map. Set up cleaning record form to be filled in by all people cleaning vehicles.	3	June2020	No cost
Set up signs for green and red zones of the farm and parking areas. As well as biosecurity signage	1	April2020	\$400
At the wash down facility set up a disinfectant scrubbing brushes, foot baths and sprayers to disinfect (1 percent Virkon) all equipment and footwear.	4	July2020	\$200

- Open up your biosecurity plan template in word. Open up an example plan and look at action plans
- Compile your own action plan, prioritise it and estimate the implementation cost
- Incorporate these actions into your farm plan
- Your biosecurity plan should now be complete. Well done!
